## Helpful Information about The Goldsboro Rotary/Wayne Community College Field of Honor®

We are extremely grateful for your support of our inaugural Field of Honor®. As you can imagine, our plans have changed due to current mandates regarding COVID-19 restrictions. We have made changes that we hope will not substantially affect your visit to the field.

Below is some helpful information about the event:

### Opening Ceremony

While we had originally hoped to host an Opening Ceremony that would be open to the public, current restrictions due to COVID-19 will not allow this to take place. The Opening Ceremony has been scaled back but will be streamed live on **Thursday, September 17<sup>th</sup> at 1:00pm** on our Facebook page ([@goldsbororotary](#)) and on Wayne Community College's Facebook page ([@waynecnc](#)).

### Visiting the Field of Honor®

The field will be open during daylight hours only. It is the universal custom to display flags only from sunrise to sunset. However, when a patriotic effect is desired, the flag may be displayed 24 hours a day if properly illuminated during the hours of darkness. While there will be some additional lighting of the field during overnight hours, it will not be adequate enough to allow your enjoyment of the field or to ensure your safety. We respectfully ask that you visit the field during daylight hours only.

### COVID-19/Social Distancing

When visiting the campus of Wayne Community College, you must first visit the COVID tent for a quick health screening. Also, while on the campus, you must wear a mask and observe social distancing protocols. Wayne Community College has been gracious to offer the use of their lawn but we all must adhere to their COVID-19 and social distancing requirements. This cannot be disregarded.

The flags have been laid out at a distance of eight feet from one another to aid in maintaining social distancing protocols.

### Locating Your Flag(s)

Each flag will be tagged with the name of that flag's honoree as well as the name of the donor. The field will be set up with six rows, each having 50 flags in each row. The tag will be indexed based on the row in which the flag is located (A, B, C, etc.) and the column (1, 2, 3, etc.). The index will note the location as B3, for example. The index will be located on the sponsor sign at the front of the field and will also be available on our website ([www.goldsbororotary.org](#)) after the Opening Ceremony on September 17<sup>th</sup>.

### Returning Your Flag to You

At the conclusion of the event, the display will be dismantled and each flag will be folded and sorted. If you requested that your flag be returned to you, club members will be available on Thursday, November 19th from 2:00pm until 4:00pm at the display. During this time, you may pick up your flag and your commemorative coin. If you cannot pick up your flag during this time frame, we will coordinate with you a day and time to return your flag to you.
